
BABY BOOMERS HAVE LONGEST HOME TENURE IN NEW REPORT

A new report published by Redfin found that baby boomers are staying in their homes thus; contributing to longer homeowner tenure. This finding is directly correlated to the inventory shortage seen nationwide.

"Nearly 40% of baby boomers have lived in their home for at least 20 years, and another 16% have lived in their home for 10-19 years. For Gen Xers, more than one-third (35%) have lived in the same home for at least 10 years"



The report also found that homeowners stay put longest in California.

"Homeowners stay put longest in California. The typical Los Angeles homeowner has lived in their home for 18.7 years, followed by 17.8 years in San Jose, CA. Next come Cleveland, OH (17.4), San Francisco (16.7) and Memphis, TN (16.5). Californians tend to hold onto their homes for a long time partly because they're incentivized to do so by Proposition 13."
