El Cerrito, Spanish for "the little hill," is a neighborhood of the Mid-City region of San Diego, California. El Cerrito is a residential neighborhood, consisting mostly of suburban homes, with some commercial activity along the streets that define its borders.

El Cerrito is unique in that the neighborhood spans residences both north and south of El Cajon Blvd. The community is bordered by 54th/Collwood Street to the West; University Avenue to the South; College Avenue to the East; and Baja Canyon, south of Baja Drive, to the North.




